

Souvignier Gris trocken 2024

Souvignier Gris is one of the new grape varieties that will shape the future. Thanks to an ingenious cross between Cabernet Seyval blanc and Zähringer, it copes better with climate change and, very importantly, requires only a fraction of the pesticides. Similar to Pinot Gris, it has slightly pink-coloured berries and is classified as a white wine variety.

The wine is comparable to Pinot Gris in terms of type, but is slightly more complex and multi-layered. Yellow fruits such as pineapple and quince, as well as light honey notes, enchant the senses. Dry but not too dry, it can beautifully showcase its fruitiness. Paired with a rather low, well-integrated acidity, it is an excellent ambassador for the new generation of wines.
