

Spätburgunder Weißherbst feinherb 2024

100% Spätburgunder (Pinot noir)

This wine is elegant and lively, seducing the senses with its delicate rosé colour in the glass. The fine fruit sweetness is harmoniously balanced by a pleasant acidity, giving this wine a wonderfully refreshing lightness.

The nose reveals aromas of ripe strawberries, juicy raspberries and a hint of red currants. The palate reveals a delicately tart structure, complemented by a subtle minerality. The finish is fruity and long-lasting, making this Weißherbst a real treat.

This Pinot Noir Weißherbst feinherb is a versatile accompaniment to light summer cuisine. It goes particularly well with fresh summer salads, grilled salmon, a light poultry salad or pasta with a light tomato sauce. It is also a very popular guest at any barbecue party.

Thanks to its freshness and fruitiness, this Weißherbst is also ideal as an aperitif on warm summer evenings.
